Delegation of Mid Career Management Course visits Safe City Islamabad

Following the special directions of ICCPO Dr. Akbar Nasir Khan, the Deputy Director Technical welcomed the Mid-Career Management Course delegation from the National Police Academy at the Safe City Islamabad, a public relations officer said. He said that, the delegation visits the command and control center, the data hub unit, modern technology-equipped cameras, and the Police operations center hall. They were fully briefed about the procedures and advantages of this project. Furthermore, the delegation was briefed that Safe City Islamabad is playing a significant role in various departments through modern techniques, including the Police Operations Center, Emergency Control Center, Data Hub Unit, Dispatch Control Center, E-Challan System, and the "Pucar-15" helpline. The delegation was



also apprised of the functionality and benefits of the Safe City cameras in the city. The modern cameras of Safe City are playing a crucial role in ensuring the safety of the city and preventing crimes and safeguarding the lives and property of citizens. Additionally, 42% of crimes are resolved through the Safe City Command and Control Center. Facial recognition cameras have been installed at the entry and



exit points of the city which are playing an important role in identifying suspicious elements, he maintained. The delegation also met with CPO Safe City and Traffic and acknowledged the modern technical system of the Islamabad Capital Police and its benefits. The delegation expressed special gratitude to ICCPO Dr. Akbar Nasir Khan and his team for this successful visit.

Islamabad Capital Police Dolphin Squad playing vital role in eradicating crime

The Islamabad capital police Dolphin is playing a vital role in crime prevention from the city, during the last 24 hours, the Dolphin checked a total of 2,816 suspicious persons, motorcycles and vehicles, a public relations officer said. He said that, following the special directions of the Islamabad Capital City Police Officer (ICCPO) Dr. Akbar Nasir Khan, the Islamabad Capital Police Dolphin Squad is working under a safe city Islamabad centralized system, which is deployed in different areas of the city for patrolling and crime prevention. During the last 24 hours, the Dolphin Squad Islamabad checked 844 pedestrians and 1,972 motorcycles during the special and snap checking, out of which 24 suspicious individuals and 66 motorcycles were shifted to various police stations for verification purposes. Islamabad Capital Police Dolphin Squad also ensured the arrest of the numerous accused involved in different criminal activities. The Islamabad capital police are taking all out efforts to curb the crime from the city. "Safety and security of the citizens is our prime responsibility and no stone would be unturned to save the lives and property of the citizens".

Campaign for registration of house servants and tenants data in full swing

According to details, following the special orders of Islamabad Capital City Police Officer (ICCPO) Dr. Akbar Nasir Khan, the Islamabad Capital Police "Knock the Door" campaign for the registration of employees and tenants is in full swing, a public relations officer said. He said that, during this campaign various teams of Islamabad Capital Police are going to the streets and door-to-door to ensure the registration of tenants and domestic workers as well as to inquire about the problems faced by the citizens. In this regard, the Counter Terrorism Department

(CTD) Islamabad has registered a data of 238 house servants of 559 houses from Khanna and Bani gala Police Station jurisdiction. The purpose of this campaign is to avoid any untoward incident by maintaining law and order in the federal capital adding that the registration of tenants and domestic workers could not only keep a close watch on miscreants but also prevent the elements involved in any kind of suspicious activity. He said citizens are also requested that they can ask for the identity of a person if someone dressed in civil clothes comes to their house in order



to collect the data. Unregistered employees and tenants could be involved in serious incidents like theft and robbery by impersonating as a common citizen and Islamabad Capital Police is trying to provide a safe environment to the citizens of the federal capital by using all its resources.

21 outlaws arrested; drugs and weapons recovered

Islamabad Capital Police apprehended 21 outlaws including four professional beggars from different areas of the city during the last 24 hours and recovered drugs and weapons from their possession, a public relations officer said. He said that, following the special directions of Islamabad Capital City Police Officer (ICCPO) Dr. Akbar Nasir Khan, the Islamabad Capital Police has intensified crackdown against the criminal elements in order to eliminate the crime from the city. Following these directions, the Aabpara police team arrested an accused namely Ahmed Ali and recovered one 30 bore pistol from his possession. The Ramna police team arrested a lady accused namely Omolade Sarah and recovered 96 wine bottles from her possession. Likewise, the Golra police team arrested an accused namely Abid Mehmood and recovered 1,175 gram heroin from his possession. The Tarnol police team arrested an accused namely Shaker and recovered one 30 bore pistol from his possession. Similarly, the Industrial Area police team arrested an accused namely Muhammad Kamran and recovered one 30 bore pistol from his possession. The

Shams Colony police team arrested two accused namely Jamal Ud din and Khair Ullah and recovered one 30 bore pistol and one dagger from their possession. Moreover, the Bhara Kahu police team arrested three accused namely Shakeeb, Adnan Rafique and Ghulam Jaffar and recovered one 30 bore pistol, 1,050 gram hashish and 25 liters liquor from their possession. The Nilore police team arrested two accused namely Jawad Alam and Abdul Waheed and recovered 15 liters of liquor and one 32 bore revolver from their possession. Further-more, the Shahzad Town police team arrested an accused namely Baber Khan and recovered 10 liters of alcohol from his possession. The Khanna police team arrested an accused Kamran

Shahzad and recovered 151 gram heroin from his possession. The Humak police team arrested three accused namely Naseer Ahmed, Shakeel and Waqas and recovered 948 gram heroin from their possession. Cases have been registered against the nabbed accused and further investigation is underway. During the crackdown against professional beggars, the Islamabad Capital Police teams arrested four professional beggars and registered cases against them under the beggars act. Senior police officers directed the police officials to further intensify the crackdown against the criminal elements. "Safety and security of the citizens is our foremost priority and no laxity will be tolerated in this regard.



Three wanted members of two snatcher gang held; mobile, motorbike and weapons recovered

Islamabad Capital Police Industrial Area and Shahzad Town police team arrested three wanted members of two notorious snatcher gangs involved in numerous criminal activities and recovered motorbike, mobile phones and weapons used in crime from their possession, a public relations officer said. Police team also recovered weapons used in crime



from their possession. Cases were registered against the nabbed accused and further investigation is underway. Citizens are urged to cooperate with the police and report any suspicious individuals or activities through the emergency helpline "Pucar-15" or via "ICT-15" mobile application.

10 absconders involved in heinous crime held

Islamabad Capital Police have arrested 10 absconders and proclaimed offenders involved in heinous crime during the last 24 hour, a public relations officer said. He said that, following the special directions of Islamabad Capital City Police Officer (ICCPO) Dr. Akbar Nasir Khan, special tasks were assigned to all senior police officials

to ensure the arrest of proclaimed offenders and absconders involved in heinous crimes. During the crackdown, the Islamabad Capital police teams have arrested 10 absconders and proclaimed offenders involved in heinous crime during the last 24 hours. Police Khidmat Markaz issued 93,942 General Police verification certificates



Police Khidmat Markaz of Islamabad Capital Police have facilitated citizens with different services like issuance of character certificate, foreigners' registration, registration of tenants and domestic servants, a police public relations officer said. He said that, following the special directions of Islamabad Capital City Police Officer (ICCPO) Dr Akbar Nasir Khan, the Islamabad capital police is taking all possible steps to provide maximum facilities to the citizens of Islamabad adding that several steps have been taken by the police in this regard. He further said that Police Khidmat Markaz has received 94,047 applications for a general police verification certificate during the ongoing year. On which 93,942 general police verification certificates were issued to the citizens after complete verification by concerned police stations while the work on remaining applications were under process. For general police verification certificates, applicants must bring his/her original CNIC. In case, the Islamabad address is not mentioned on applicant's CNIC, he must bring residential proof or rental agreement. For citizen's facility, police mobile facilitation van service has also been working, while Khidmat Markaz in various areas including sectors F-6, G-10/4, H-11, Bani Gala, Swan Garden, Khanna and at different police stations were also facilitating the citizens. ICCPO Dr. Akbar Nasir Khan said that, well trained staff has been appointed there who are providing best services to Pakistani nationals and foreigners. Such steps would improve the trust of people in the police.

SSP CTD arranges "Iftar dinner" with police officials

Pucar-15 helpline received 3,792 irrelevant calls during the last 24 hours

Islamabad capital police emergency helpline "Pucar-15" received 4,362 phone calls during the last 24 hours and provided immediate assistance on various help seeking calls including police, fire brigade, ambulance and other services, a public relations officer said. He said that 4,362 calls were received at the emergency helpline "Pucar-15" out of which 3,792 calls were hoax and irrelevant to police which make up 87% of all calls. The Islamabad Capital City Police Officer (ICCPO) Dr. Akbar Nasir Khan took notice of hoax calls on the police emergency helpline and directed the senior officers to take stern legal action against those involved in such activities. "If anyone tries to waste the time of the police by making fake calls or passing derogatory remarks to the personnel will be dealt with iron hands," he maintained. ICCPO Dr. Akbar Nasir Khan urged the masses to approach police only in emergency situations as some genuine cases needing police attention may be neglected because of the time consumed by hoax calls.

Over 2,63,310 e-challan tickets issued through safe city cameras

Islamabad Capital Police safe city e-challan system has issued over 2,63,310 fine tickets to motorists over various traffic rules violations in federal capital Islamabad through safe city cameras so far, a public relations officer said. He said that, following the special directions of Islamabad Capital City Police Officer (ICCPO) Dr. Akbar Nasir Khan, the Islamabad Capital Police is utilizing all available resources and taking strict measures against the traffic rules violators according

to law. According to the details, the Islamabad Capital Police have issued 116 e-challan tickets during the last 24 hours and a total of 2,63,310 e-challan tickets to motorists have been issued over various traffic rules violations so far. E-challan tickets were delivered to the violators at their home address. A copy of challan was attached with the master file of the vehicles at the excise office over non-payment of penalty amount within the given time, he added. The car owners who

were subjected to a fine could not sell or transfer their vehicle until the clearance of dues. The fine amount could be paid through different banks, mobile accounts and other digital means. There was a significant decline observed in the number of road mishaps and traffic violations in the federal capital after introducing this new challan system. The move was aimed at getting residents of the capital to abide by traffic laws even in the absence of traffic officers.

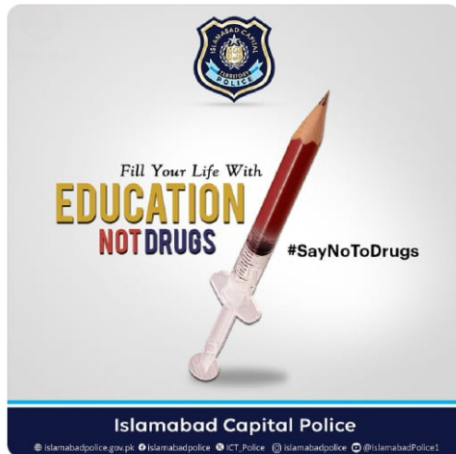
