Search operations conducted in multiple police stations jurisdiction

Following the directives of Inspector General of Police (IGP) Islamabad Syed Ali Nasir Rizvi, special measures are being undertaken to curb criminal activities and to ensure the safety and security of the federal capital.

In line with these directions, search and combing operations are being carried out on a regular basis across different parts of Islamabad.

In this regard, search and combing operations were conducted in the jurisdiction of Tarnol ,Golra and Bhara Kahu police stations under the supervision of zonal SP's.

During the operations, 195 individuals, 97 houses, four shops, 53 motorcycles and 28 vehicles were thoroughly checked, while 12 suspicious persons were shifted to police stations for legal proceedings.

SSP Operations Islamabad Qazi Ali Raza, emphasized that the primary objective of these operations is to tighten the security cordon around criminal elements and to further strengthen the overall security framework of the city.

14 criminals arrested; narcotics and weapons recovered

Following the special directives of Inspector General of Police (IGP) Islamabad Syed Ali Nasir Rizvi, an effective crackdown is ongoing across the federal capital to ensure the safety of citizens' lives and property by combating crime and arresting criminal elements.

In this regard, police teams from Ramna, Tarnol, Sangjani, Industrial Area, Noon, Khanna, Humak, Phulgran and Shahzad Town police stations arrested 11 accused and recovered huge amounts of heroin, Ice, three pistols and one Kalashankof along with ammunition from their possession. Cases have been registered against the arrested accused, and further investigation is in progress.

Additionally, during a special campaign launched for the arrest of proclaimed offenders and court absconders, three wanted criminals were also apprehended.
