IGP Islamabad reviews police affairs and development projects

Search operations conducted in multiple police stations jurisdiction

Following the directives of Inspector General of Police (IGP) Islamabad Syed Ali Nasir Rizvi, special measures are being undertaken to curb criminal activities and to ensure the safety and security of the federal capital.

In line with these directions, search and combing operations are being carried out on a regular basis across different parts of Islamabad.

In this regard, search and combing operations were conducted in the jurisdiction of Tarnol , Phulgran, Sangjani and Aabpara police stations under the supervision of zonal SP's.

During the operations, 298 individuals, 96 houses, 27 shops, 98 motorcycles and 44 vehicles were thoroughly checked, while 23 suspicious persons, five motorcycles and one vehicle were shifted to police stations for legal proceedings.

SSP Operations Islamabad Qazi Ali Raza, emphasized that the primary objective of these operations is to tighten the security cordon around criminal elements and to further strengthen the overall security framework of the city.

He further added that Islamabad Police will continue indiscriminate actions against criminals, land grabbers and drug traffickers.

He also urged citizens to cooperate with the police and to immediately report any suspicious activity to the nearest police station or through the emergency helpline "Pucar-15".

31 outlaws arrested; drugs and weapons recovered

According to the details, the Islamabad Police Aabpara, Koral, Humak and Nilore police station teams arrested 10 accused involved in different criminal activities.

Police teams also recovered 1,035 gram ice, 37 bottles of liquor and five pistols with ammunition from their possession. Cases have been registered against the arrested accused and further investigations are ongoing.

SSP Investigations holds meeting on ongoing criminal cases
