30 outlaws arrested, drugs and weapons recovered

According to the details, the Islamabad Police Kohsar, Margalla, Karachi Company, Khanna, Lohi Bher, Shehzad Town, Bani Gala police station teams arrested 16 accused involved in different criminal activities.

Police teams also recovered 3362 gram crystal meth, 150 Gram heroin, 20 bottles of liquor, 10 pistols with ammunition and one dagger from their possession. Cases have been registered against them and further investigations are ongoing.

Additionally, during a special campaign launched for the arrest of proclaimed offenders and absconders, various police teams arrested 14 criminals.

Following the special directions of IGP Islamabad Syed Ali Nasir Rizvi, the Islamabad Police continues its effective crackdown against crime and criminal elements to ensure the peace and tranquility in the federal capital.

561 individuals checked during search operations across Islamabad

Following the directives of Inspector General of Police (IGP) Islamabad Syed Ali Nasir Rizvi, special measures are being undertaken to curb criminal activities and ensure the safety and security of the federal capital.

In this regard, search and combing operations were conducted in the jurisdictions of multiple police stations under the supervision of zonal SPs.

During the operations, 561 individuals, 172 houses, 43 shops, 16 hotels, 271 motorcycles, and 81 vehicles were thoroughly checked. Meanwhile, 26 suspicious persons, 02 illegally residing foreign nationals, 25 motorcycles, and one vehicle were shifted to police stations for legal proceedings.

SSP Operations Islamabad Qazi Ali Raza, emphasized that the primary objective of these operations is to tighten the security cordon around criminal elements and further strengthen the overall security framework of the city.

He further added that Islamabad Police will continue indiscriminate action against criminals, land grabbers, and drug traffickers.

He also urged citizens to cooperate with the police and immediately report any suspicious activity to the nearest police station or through the emergency helpline "Pucar-15".
